CLA CINECA System - Enrollment in Language Practice Sessions

Enrollment in language practice sessions (courses) starting from the 2025/26 academic year is mandatory. Enrollment is done through the CLA – CINECA system.

Access

To access the system, use the links published on various pages of the CLA website, your degree program's website, and on MyUnivr. Access is granted to all students who are enrolled and have GIA credentials.

The system opens with a catalog page displaying all the language practice sessions that will be offered in the first semester (and later in the second semester) of the 2025/26 academic year. Click on ACCESS.




You will then see the login screen where you can enter your GIA credentials.



At the first login, the system checks the student's study plan and copies the language competencies required by the plan into the student's dashboard. Since this verification is repeated at each subsequent login, any modifications to the study plan are automatically propagated from ESSE3 into CLA CINECA.

Accessing Competencies Imported from ESSE3 and Selecting Practice Sessions



Select the Career tab, and the following screen will appear:



Check that in the "language tests to be completed" section, all the language competencies you plan to achieve at the center are listed (this set of competencies is called the CLA booklet). The cards display the competencies derived from the current content of the ESSE3 booklet. There may be additional competencies already acquired; CINECA is currently processing and updating this data.

Choosing Language Practice Sessions (Language course).

In the "Prove di lingua da completare" section, click on a specific competency. The sessions for the upcoming semester related to that competency will be shown.



Clicking on the NAME of the competency will bring up a pop-up window showing the

recommended practice sessions (courses "Corsi suggeriti").



In any case, you can always go to the catalog to view the complete list of courses.




In the catalog, search for the sessions (courses) you're interested in by selecting the STUDENT

card,



and then set the search filter by language and level.



IMPORTANT: For some degree programs, dedicated sessions are provided. In this case, the name of the session will include a label to help identify the dedicated course (for example, HUMANITIES). There may also be multiple offerings of the same session (e.g., Group 1, Group 2, etc.); in this case, choose based on other factors such as schedule, location, etc. To access more details about a session, click the "SCOPRI DI PIÙ" button".



When enrollment is open, just click the ENROLL button to register for the session (course).

Enrollment in the session will then appear on your dashboard.
